Brenna:

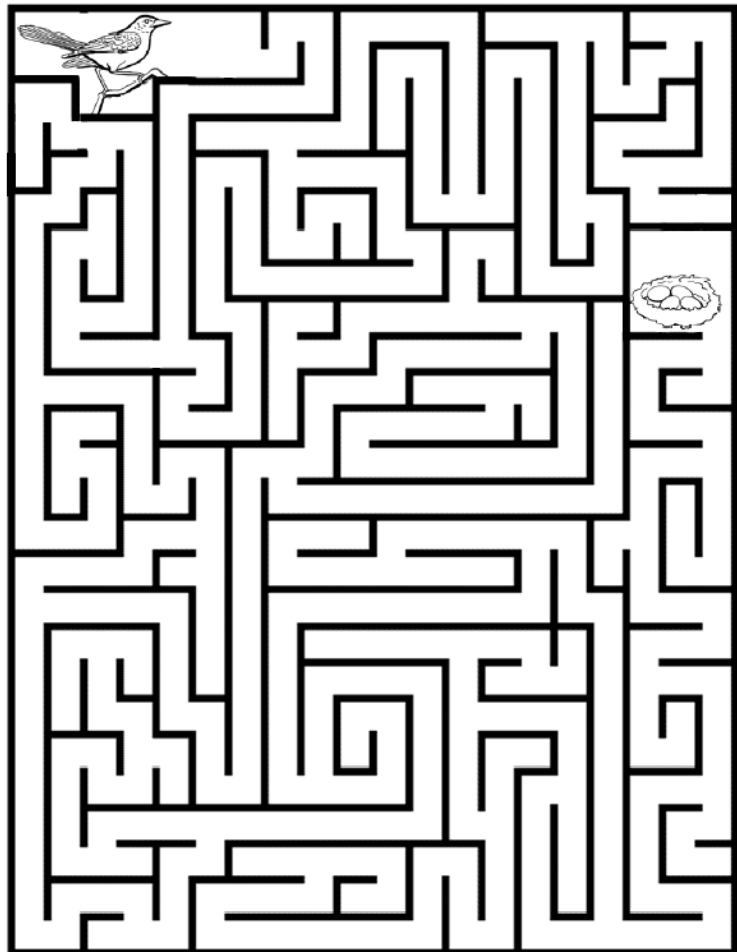
We are studying teeth. We have learned that when your tooth gets loose, the new grown up tooth is coming in.
