We are also having a substitute because our teacher's son has an ear infection.


Why did the football coach go to the bank?

Why is 6 afraid of 7?




Because 7 ate 9!


**Conrad and Alana

This is the end of me!




More classroom news.....

We're off!


**Ashley and Kristian

Steve: What is it?


