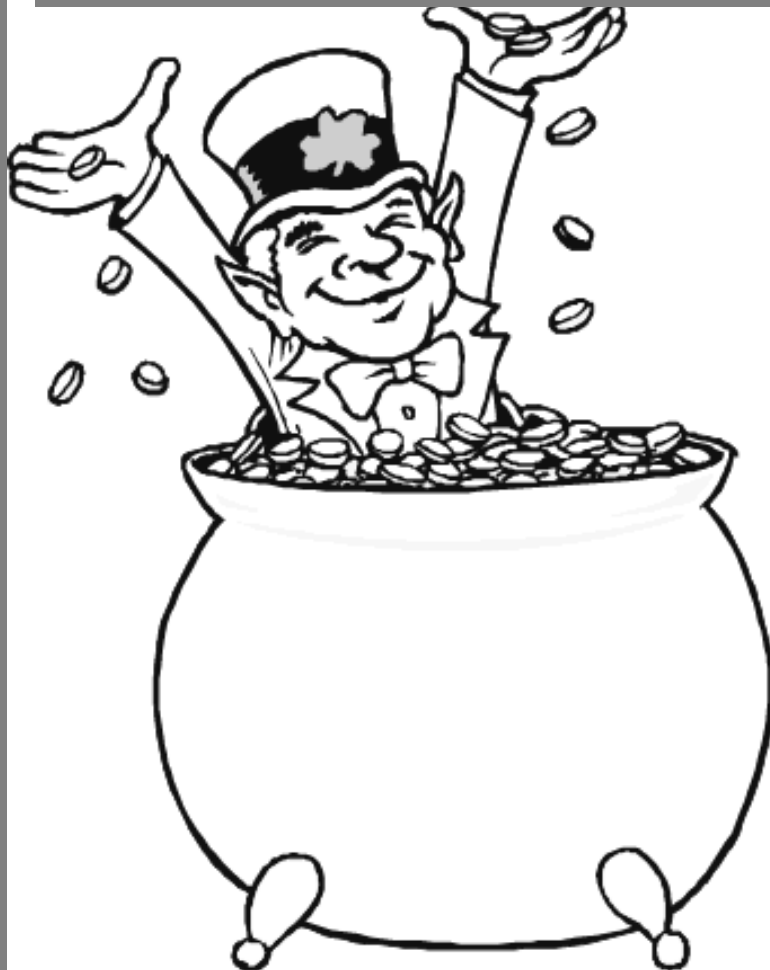

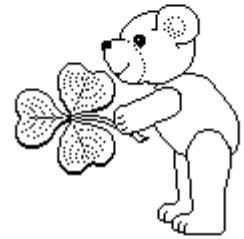
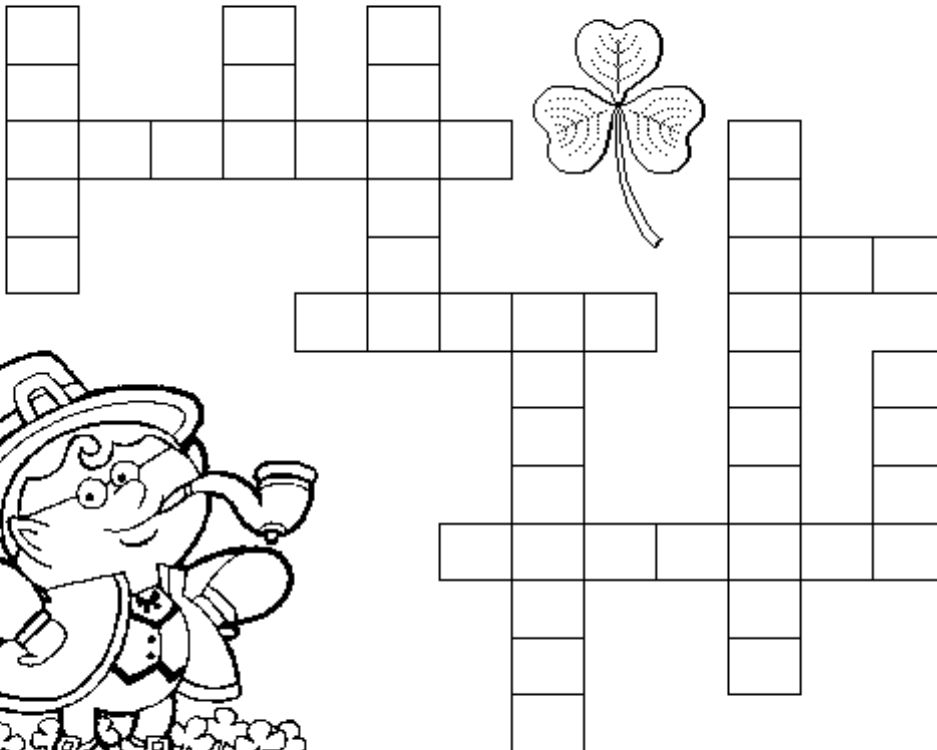
We are studying about balance. We are balancing a lot of things, and we made equal arm balances.
