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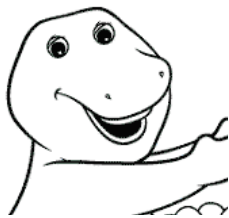

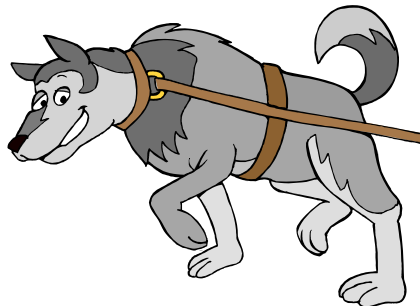

Why is a river rich?



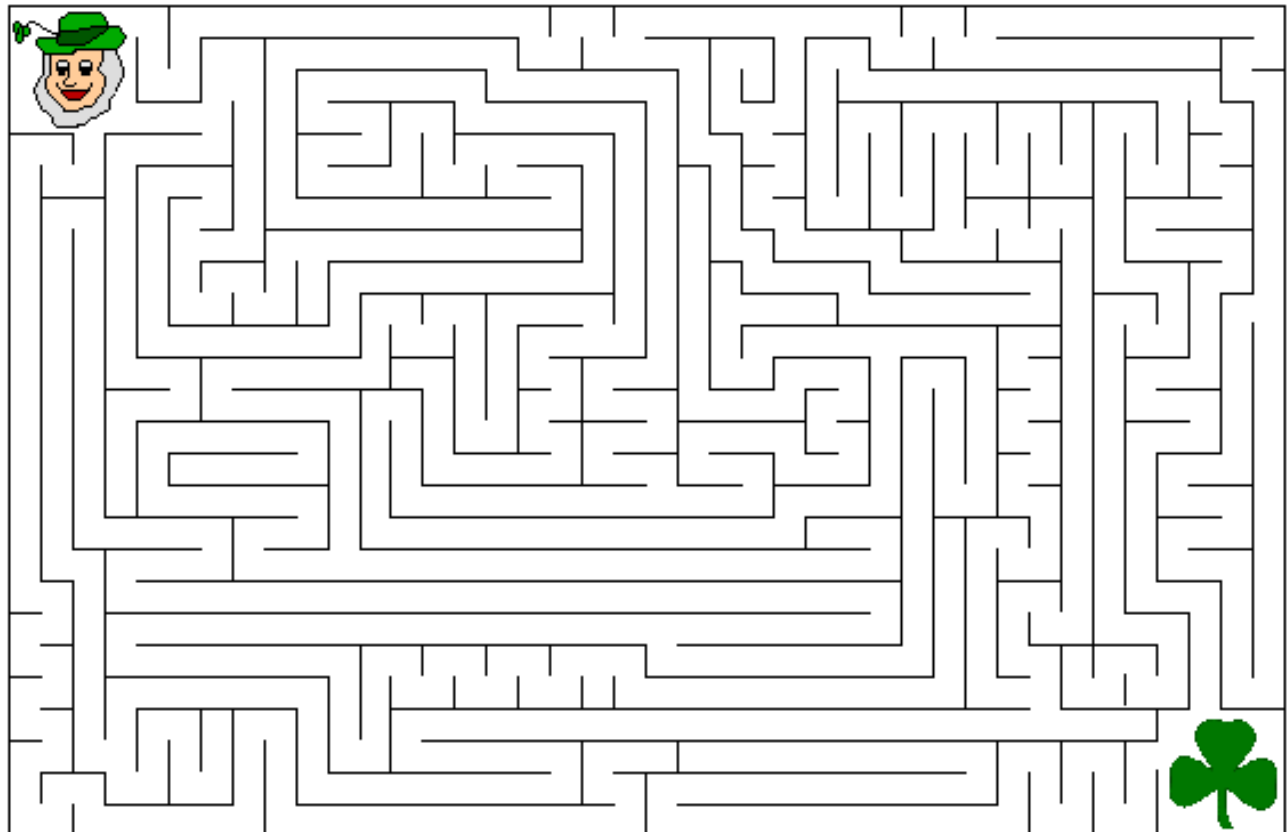

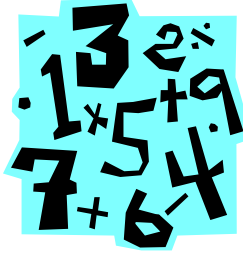

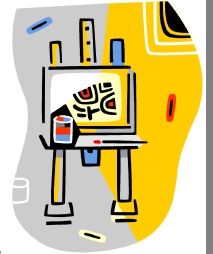


In social studies we are studying native Americans, we are making people, and a model of a village.

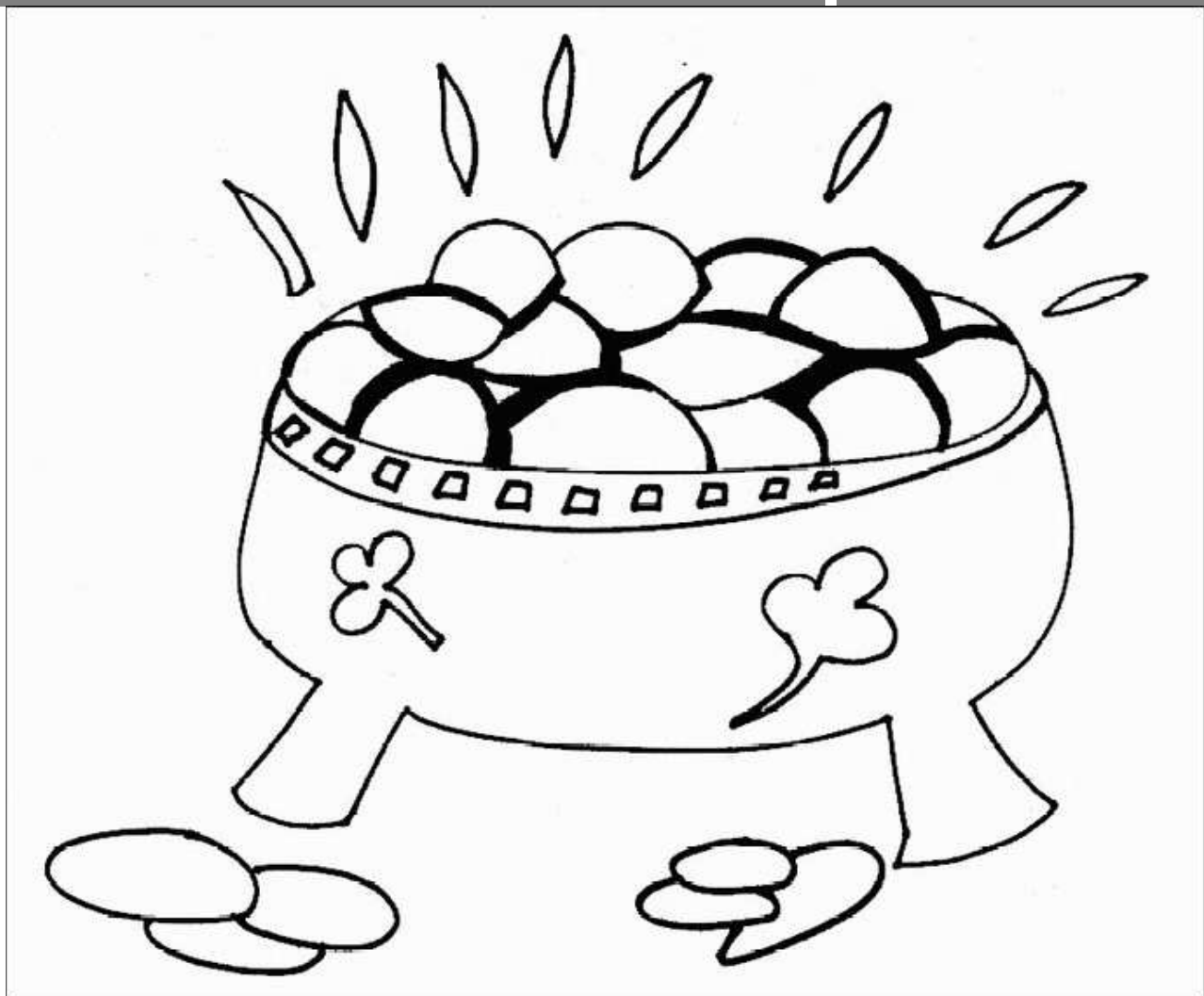
Room 1, Grade 1

Room 7, Grade 4**

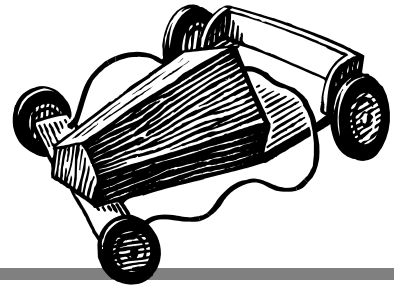

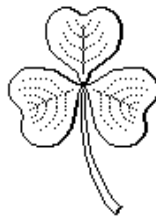
