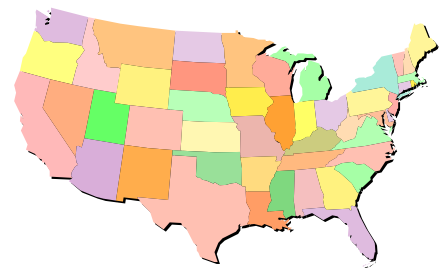
Chloe and Kaylah
