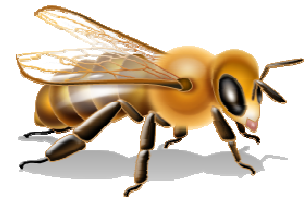

We are good writers. We love this whole school. We are very smart. We have learned a lot. School is fun. We come every day. The playground is fun. We have nice friends.

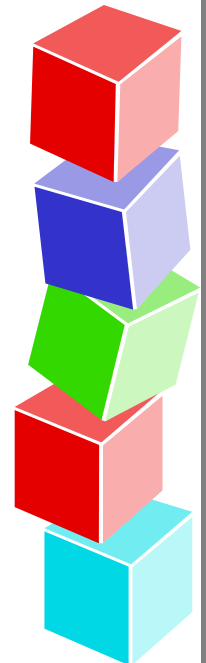
**Rene and Justin

Room 4, Kindergarten**

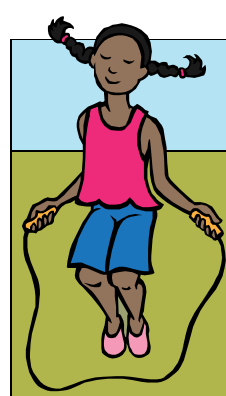
