Q: Why did the Earth put on a T-shirt?

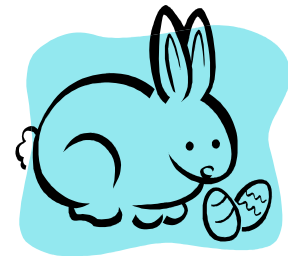


A: It was global warming.

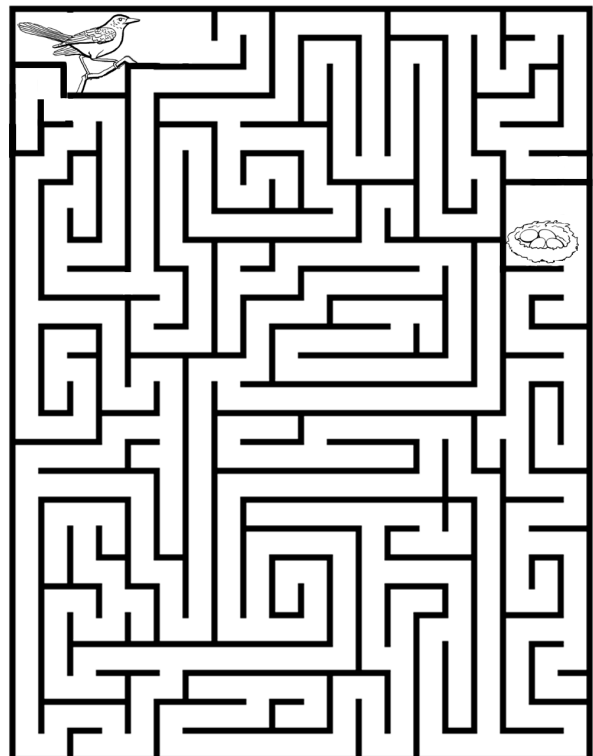

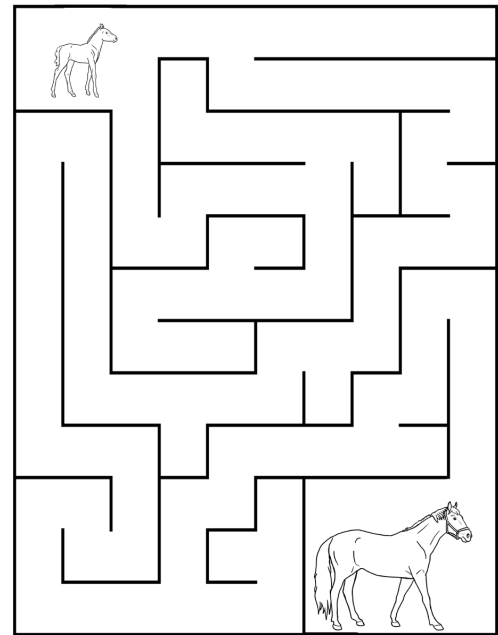
