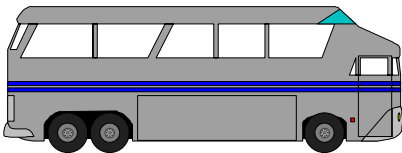

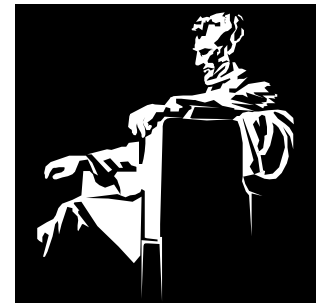
Brittany and Matthew

Room 9, Grade 3

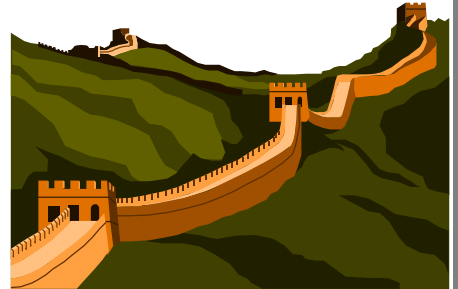

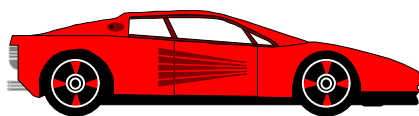

Because he wanted hot wheels.

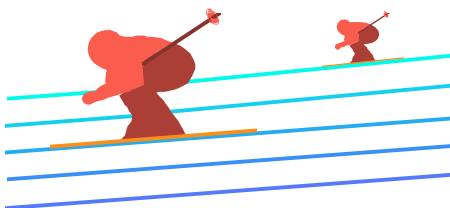


Evelyn and Kevin

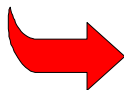
Special from Rooms 25, 24, and 21
