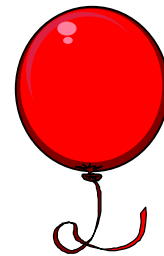
Forecast by Lindsay

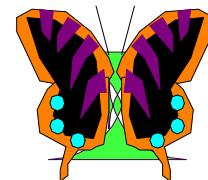

Anna and Kristina Grade 1, Room 19

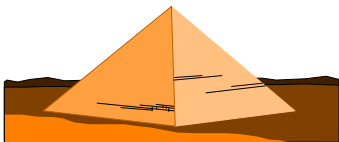
We planted seeds. They are growing higher and higher each day we come to school. We made our books for Young Authors' Day.
